

The library is open to all who seek inspiration and want to expand their knowledge about what's new in art in this country and abroad. Readers can choose from Czech and foreign art publications, as well as fiction and books on the philosophy and sociology of art and critical views on the run of institutions and exhibitions.

A specific feature of the library is the unconventional arrangement of the books by the artist Jan Šerých who designed the library as an autonomous work of art. For example, the publications in one of the sections are arranged after colour, in another after size. Although this approach might be slightly confusing for practical orientation, it rewards the user with some unexpected finds.
